Important Rules

- This study plan is designed for students taking part in the mentioned Double Degree Program and spending the academic year 2023/2024 at Tilburg University.
- Interested students are required to read and understand the study plan and its rules. These are to be considered binding to the successful completion of the double degree program. Changes to the study plan are usually not possible and any request in this sense must be conveyed to the International Development Office that cannot guarantee its feasibility.
- The list of courses to be taken abroad may be subject to changes should the academic offer at Tilburg University be amended.
- The listed exams must be taken and passed in the academic year indicated in the scheme (not after). Any possible change must be formally authorized by the Academic Commission.
- During the mobility, students will be subject to the rules of Tilburg University.
- At the end of the program, if compliant with both Luiss and Tilburg academic requirements, students will obtain both the Master in Law (LLM) in International and European Law (issued by Tilburg) and the Master's Degree in Law, Digital Innovation and Sustainability (issued by Luiss).

Thesis

- Students will complete their theses during their mobility period at Tilburg (2023/2024), with two supervisors, one from each university.
- Both supervisors need to approve the proposal, which must meet the standards of both institutions.
- Students will defend their theses in Tilburg at the end of the second year (June or August) and in Rome in the Autumn Session in October / November.
- Students must respect the thesis procedures and deadlines from both institutions. Each institution will grade the final thesis according to its own standards.
- Students will be required to have passed all courses and obtained all credits prior to defend their thesis at Luiss
- The student is responsible for maintaining regular contact with supervisors from both partner universities throughout the writing process.
- Students are reminded that they are required to comply with the Luiss regular procedure regarding the thesis assignment, registration for the degree exam and upload of the thesis. For further information, please check the [following page](#).
